Pastor Maxwell H. Ware is the Senior Pastor of Cornerstone Church, located in Columbia, Maryland. He committed his life totally to Christ at Wilson and Fair Church of God hearing Rev. Raymond Steele preach on living water.He went to the altar and received the infilling of the Holy Spirit Pastor Ware earned a Bachelors' Degree from the University of Nebraska at Omaha, and an MBA from Adelphi University in Garden City, Long Island, New York.

He also attended Central Bible College. He served the local church in various capacities such as: Youth Leader, Sunday School Teacher, Building Fund Chairman, Treasurer, a Board of Trustee Member, Teacher in School of the Bible, and as an Associate Minister at Long Reach Church of God prior to establishing Cornerstone. He also served the national church on the Warner Press Company Board of Directors.

Presently he provides leadership in the CDP District of the Church of God as the Chair of the Elder Board. Pastor Ware served in the military for sixteen years during the Vietnam era and is a Major in the United State Army Retired Reserve. He worked in private industry for two fortunes five hundred companies in Commercial Real Estate Financing.

CORNERSTONE CHURCH HISTORY

In the summer of 1998, Pastor Maxwell Ware felt an urging of the Lord to begin a church. The call from The Lord was strong and scripturally based. It was revealed to him that his decision released his destiny. There is a standing command from the Lord "Go into all the world and preach the Gospel."

Bishop Robert S. Davis, Senior, Pastor, of Long Reach Church of God (where Bro. & Sis. Ware had been a member for 14 years), consented and commissioned them for this new work. Cornerstone Community Church of God was founded and held the first organizational meeting September 6, 1998, in the basement of the Ware's home. Later they began to meet at the Amherst House, located in the Village of King's Contrivance, Columbia, Md.

There were five families that began with Pastor and Sis. Ware, (1) Gerald and Mildred Boyd, (2) Ted and Bobbie Crew, (3) Steve and Rhonda Cromwell, (4) Calvin and Stephanie Cross, and (5) Brenda Pinkney. Each Sunday we invited visitors to the church, and many became members.

The Covenant Group (leadership team) was appointed and became an active and dynamic group, providing counsel and leadership within the church led by Chris Gallant serving as Chairperson.

In 1999 the Mighty Men of Cornerstone (MMOC) began meeting early each Saturday Morning in Fellowship at the Pastor's home. The MMOC took the lead organizing The Annual Labor Day Cookout.

Cornerstone sponsored a Marriage Enrichment Seminar conducted by Dr. Alvin Lewis and Dr. Juanita Lewis. Cornerstone messages were heard on the Radio over Heaven 600 AM. We had a weekly broadcast that aired on Sunday Evening at 6:30 pm. Intercessory prayer has always been an integral part of Cornerstone's Ministry. Breakthrough Prayer on Thursday Night. We also began Power Up in 15 each weekday morning at 6:00 am for those who want to dial in on the prayer line for 15 minutes of prayer before beginning their day. Cornerstone intercedes for the people of God, the church worship services, and for world conditions.

Early in the ministry Cornerstone supported Minister Brenda Pinkney as a full-time Missionary to Haiti. Presently Cornerstone supports Pastor Audrey Boudreaux's ministry to Haiti and through her organization "Beyond all Boundaries." Cornerstone served the community with excellent childcare through Cornerstone early learning center.

We also had Rainbow Adult Day Care as a tenant for over seven years. We have shared the use of our building for worship with other faith communities such as Columbia Community Seven Day Adventist Church, Hope Presbyterian, Chin Bible Church, Burmese Bible Church, and Movement Church of God.


During life of the church, we have had some low points losing First Lady Beverly Ware suddenly. Although the church and Pastor Ware prayed fervently for her Healing, Sis Beverly transitioned into glory on February 3, 2010. However, Pastor Ware never lost his hope in God, and promised God he would redouble his efforts in ministry.

After a lonely period in his life, the God of all hope, brought a new joy and strength into his life. He married Sheila Joy Baratta on January 4, 2014. God promised Pastor Ware many more years of productive ministry, and First Lady Sheila Ware has come alongside to help him fulfill his assignment to "finish well." We still believe that God has set before us an open door that no one can shut (Rev.3:8).

God has been faithful and continues to show us favor as we have matured as a church that is growing, developing and moving into the fullness of its mission in the world. We believe that the faithful God that has begun a good work in us and will See it to completion (Phil. 1:6). Our prayer is that all those who see what Cornerstone Church has accomplished will agree that it had to be God and He is still doing great things! And we believe that
